Sharing Knowledge

To make informed decisions that lead to healthier development, stronger relationships, and greater overall well-being, young people need activities that provide practical, accurate, and unbiased information. Extension's Family and Consumer Sciences program has been sharing life skills training with students in the after-school program at Castlewood High School.

Focusing on real-life situations, students have taken a step toward self-reliance by learning to dehydrate and can food. Students dehydrated fruit to make "fruit leather," and they preserved strawberries by making and canning jam. They also perfected the art of making bread.

To prepare students for future independence, Extension shared lessons to help them better understand the importance of using budgets to make sound financial decisions. By providing young people with opportunities for hands-on and experiential learning, they will be better equipped to handle and solve future problems.
