#### **STRAWBERRIES**

**BARE ROOT**

**EARLIGLOW:** An early season variety that produces medium sized berries. Its sweet flavor makes this variety excellent for fresh eating and freezing. Excellent for beginners.

**ALLSTAR:** A mid to late season variety that produces a large, sweet berry. It is excellent for fresh eating, canning and freezing.

<u>JEWEL:</u> A mid to late season variety that produces large berries with superb quality and flavor. Excellent fresh eating or canning and preserving. Moderate winter hardiness.

**SEASCAPE:** A Day-Neutral (Everbearing) variety that has been highly successful for north eastern growers for summer & fall production. The berries are large, firm and have good flavor. Day-neutrals are great in containers and bear fruit the first year.

#### **BLACKBERRIES**

**TRIPLE CROWN:** Named for its three attributes: flavor, productivity and vigor. A semi-erect plant that produces very large, flavorful fruit. This **thornless** blackberry ripens for about one month and has strong canes that can support many pounds of fruit without trellising.

## **TAYBERRY**

\$10.00/BARE ROOT

**TAYBERRY:** A cross between a blackberry and a red raspberry with very large, conical shaped fruit. The sweet fruit is a beautiful purple and can be eaten fresh or cooked into jams, jellies, & more. Grows reasonably well in almost all soils and even in deep shade. Berries are ripe when they begin to fall from the plants. Vigorous canes grow 6-7 feet tall into a natural fan shape and will need trellising. Tayberries are rare and not often found in commercial markets.

## **RASPBERRIES**

#### RED & YELLOW - BARE ROOT / BLACK & PURPLE - PLUG

**HERITAGE RED:** A self-pollinating, upright variety that does not require a trellis. It produces sweet, dark red, medium-large berries - many times in the first year. Excellent for fresh eating, canning and freezing.

ROYALTY PURPLE: The sweetest & most popular purple raspberry variety today. It is very productive with large fruit. Good for fresh eating and excellent for jams & jellies. Can be picked slightly immature as a firm red berry. A late-season variety that eludes spring frost damage. It has multiple insect resistances, including immunity to raspberry aphid.

ANNE YELLOW: A mid/late-season everbearing variety with large yellow berries. The fruit is very large, sweet & firm with an excellent flavor that will liven up tarts, jams & salads. Canes are semi-erect. The plant is cold-hardy, heat tolerant, disease resistant and self-pollinating.

**BRISTOL BLACK:** This heirloom-quality variety is a high-producing variety whose upright growth and cluster formation makes its berries very easy to pick. It has medium, firm, glossy fruit with the best black raspberry flavor. It is hardy, vigorous, and shows tolerance to powdery mildew.

**SHEKINAH 'TAHI' BLACK:** The first-ever spineless black raspberry variety! This groundbreaking berry offers large fruit with a stunning deep black hue. Berries grow in tight clusters and the absence of spines ensures an effortless and pain-free harvesting experience. A vigorous & more upright plant, perfect for passionate home gardeners looking to add a unique & hassle-free berry to their garden.

#### **BLUEBERRIES**

#### \$8.00/1 gallon container ready to transplant

**PREMIER:** An early to mid-season berry producer with large fruit and excellent flavor. This variety is highly productive, grows upright and has good foliage. (Two varieties are needed for pollination.)

**POWDER BLUE:** A late season bush that is highly productive, producing large sweet fruit. It is an upright plant with good foliage. (<u>Two varieties are needed for pollination.</u>)

**YADKIN:** A mid-season plant that produces large fruit. The plant is semiupright and a moderately vigorous grower. (<u>Self-pollinating</u>)

**DUKE:** An early ripening variety that is upright and vigorous with consistently high yielding growth. Berries are medium to large in size with great color and firmness. While <u>self-pollinating</u>, this variety benefits from cross-pollination with other cultivars, producing even larger yields.

#### GRAPES \$12/BARE ROOT

SOMERSET: An early maturing & winter hardy seedless grape. It produces compact clusters with medium-sized berries and a unique, strawberry-like flavor. Fruit starts out pink, but becomes much sweeter & more flavorful after ripening on the vine until turning a full red color. Somerset is great for fresh eating, juice, & making jelly. Very vigorous and disease resistant.

NEPTUNE: Produces large, juicy & highly flavorful yellow-green seedless fruit—some of the largest white grapes available. Produces large & long clusters that are wonderful for snacking & fruit salads, but also excellent

**RELIANCE:** A great addition to the home garden. This variety produces large clusters of medium-sized, pinkish-red fruit. It has a high sugar content and tender skin making it perfect for snacking, jellies, juices, salads, & wines. One of the most cold hardy seedless variety. Blooms late to avoid spring frosts and ripens in August—30 days earlier than Concord.
