Farmers who have operations in Lee, Scott, Wise, Dickenson, Buchanan, Russell, Tazewell, Washington, Smyth, Wythe, Grayson, Carroll, and Bland Counties who meet the basic qualifications and fulfill the educational hours required will be eligible for funding based on first come first serve at their Extension Office.
