The Master Gardener training is based on a wealth of educational materials developed by The Virginia Cooperative Extension of Virginia Tech. This program is open to those individuals in southwestern Virginia who are willing to commit to providing horticultural education, information and assistance to the citizens of our communities. The training consists of 50 hours of classroom instruction and a requested minimum of 50 hours of community service within twelve months after completing the classroom training. Master Gardeners commit to 20 hours of horticulture-related service and 8 hours of continuing education hours each year after completing the training. Classes are open to gardeners of all levels and will be taught by instructors from Virginia Tech, Virginia Cooperative Extension, and experienced Master Gardeners. There will be hand-on experiences such as seed planting, lawn management, etc. Topics include Soils, Botany, Vegetable Gardening, Plant Pathology, Plant Propagation, Fruits in the Home Garden, Wildlife Habitats and many more!
